

Quinta do Albergue do Bom Jardim

Eden-esque countryside laps ups to this elegant country house, approached along the narrowest of country lanes flanked by vineyards and groves of orange, olive and almond trees. If you enjoy **wine** you should book at least one night at Bom Jardim; the owners have a well-stocked **cellar** and a cozy **bar for wine tasting**. The estate's wine is the obvious first choice. You could follow it with a glass of their self made cognac.

The four guest bedrooms are most delightful: big, light rooms with pine floors, high ceilings antique beds and dressers and carefully chosen fabrics and colors. The other two rooms are situated in an extension building and, if booked together, can be joined to make a huge apartment for six. These rooms have a south-facing veranda and are pleasantly furnished. This house also has a wood-burning stove, similar lighting conditions and the uncluttered feel of the main house. In addition, you can swim all year round in the **indoor pool** followed by a **sauna** and a **Turkish bath**. The farm offers **horse-back-riding**, **canoeing** nearby and numerous **hiking** routes. Do try to find time to visit the winery with Hubertus; he will gladly share his oenological secrets.
