



Natural Reserve - Paúl de Boquilobo

Near Golegã, situated between the rivers Tagus and Almonda, the Natural Reserve of the Paúl de Boquilobo (529 hectares) is a wetland with groves of willow and ash-trees and its inner zones, flooded during almost all year, are covered by a variety of aquatic plants and cane thickets.

The biggest colony of herons of the Iberian Peninsula lives here, and during spring it becomes an important nesting site for enormous groups of wildfowl (mainly herons and egrets).
